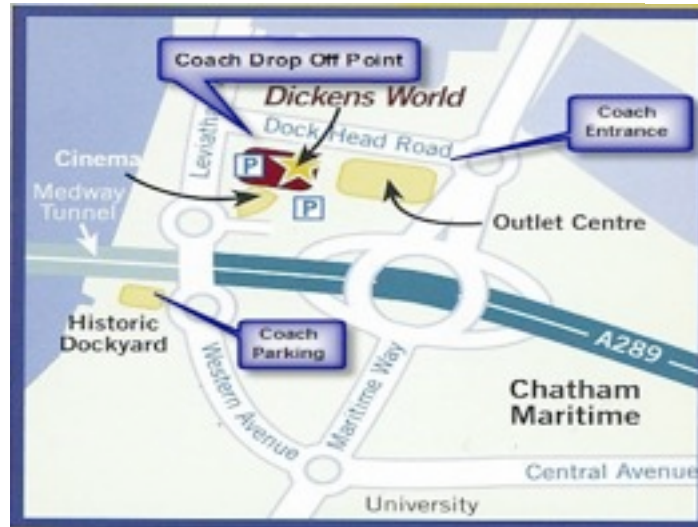


## Coach Parking Details



Dickens World is located adjacent to the Historic Dockyard, Chatham. To enter the area, please follow the brown tourist anchor signs positioned on all entry roads to the Medway area.

### Approaching from the Medway Tunnel

If approaching through the Medway Tunnel, please ensure you are in the left hand lane and take the left hand exit filter at the end of the tunnel. At the traffic lights on the roundabout, take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit. At the next roundabout, take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit again – this is Dock Head Road. Proceed for approximately 500m to the bus stop lay-by.

*The bus stop is at the rear of Dickens World – visitors are then required to make the short walk following the building round to the left to the main entrance. **Waiting is not permitted here so you will need to drop off then move to the parking bays immediately. Parking Wardens/Security patrol the area and you could get a ticket. SEEDA owns this land and impose these restrictions, we have no control over it.***

### Approaching from A289, Gillingham

Exit the A289 at the Chatham Maritime Exit – use the right hand lane as you approach the traffic lights. At this roundabout, take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit – signposted St. Mary's Island. At the next roundabout, take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit – this is Dock Head Road. Proceed for approximately 500m to the bus stop lay-by.

*The bus stop is at the rear of Dickens World – visitors are then required to make the short walk following the building round to the left to the main entrance. **Waiting is not permitted here so you will need to drop off then move to the parking bays immediately. Parking Wardens/Security patrol the area and you could get a ticket. SEEDA owns this land and impose these restrictions, we have no control over it.***

### Parking

There are several coach spaces within the main Dickens World car park – near to the Odeon cinema. Exit the drop off point continuing down Dock Head Road. At the roundabout, take the first exit. At the mini roundabout, take the first exit again. Proceed through the entrance barriers – the coach spaces are on the left hand side. Parking is free of charge for the duration of your visit.

At busy periods, alternative coach parking can be found at the Historic Dockyard, Chatham.

**PLEASE NOTE THAT THERE IS NO WAITING AT THE DROP OFF AREA. WE SUGGEST THAT YOU ARRANGE TO PICK UP YOUR GROUP AT THE PARKING BAY. THIS CAN BE SEEN FROM THE EXIT OF DICKENS WORLD, AT THE FRONT OF THE BUILDING, TO THE RIGHT AND FORWARD.**
